Where do we play?

We play behind the art museum, on 3rd and Madison, three blocks from the bars. Don't worry, there's a map here. The closest metro stops are Union Station and Judiciary Square (Federal Center is walkable too) but your best bet is to park at the bar and walk over.

Talk to your captain about trading you to another team. Trades are allowed as long as shirts are swapped and everyone is okay with the moves.

How do I contact my Captain?

If you log in in to the website (middle of the homepage) you will see contact info for your captain as well as everyone else on your team. Happy stalking!

I played in other leagues and people didn't really socialize outside of their team, but I want to. Help!

Luckily, you joined NAKID. We encourage mixing with everyone, this is why people JOIN NAKID in the first place. Don't worry, except when at the flip cup tables, people will be more than happy to chat you up - and maybe take you home.

It's 9 a.m. Tuesday and raining. Are we still gonna play?

Put this number in your phone book: 202-903-8230. That's the NAKID Hotline that you can call for weather updates. As a general rule, yes, we'll play. If not an email will be sent to the league letting you know games are off 1-2 hours before game time. When games are called off, there is free beer at the bars, so come out and play flip cup!

Are there practices?

Well, it varies by team, but generally no. Some teams throw the ball around and kick a little right before their games, but no one organizes a different time to do it. All teams have their own ball though, so maybe they will. Fields are usually setup an hour before game time, so you can practice then.
